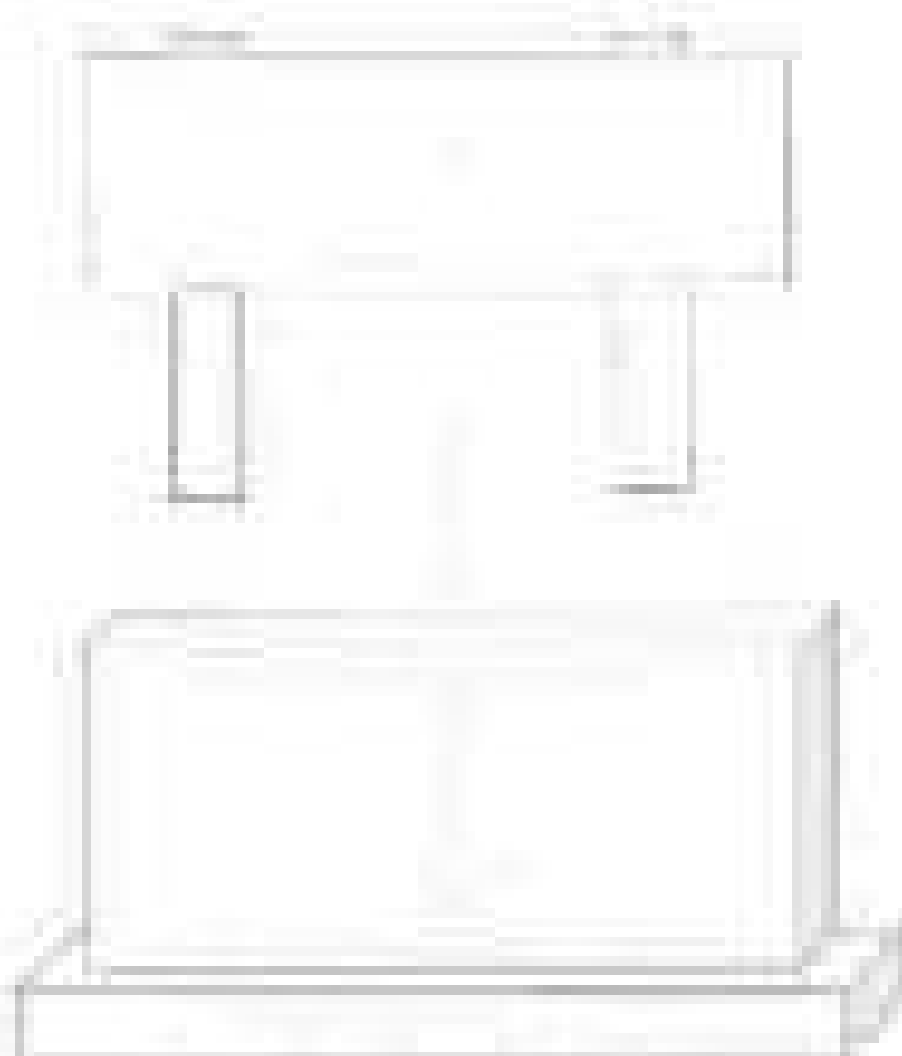


2. 2D & 3D representations of solids
